## BEGINNER I WESTERN (7-UP)

The lesson plans will concentrate on safety, becoming familiar with the horses, and teaching the basic riding skills for the first time student.

**CLASS TIMES AND DAYS: MONDAY 4:00-5:00 or WEDNESDAY 6:30-7:30 or THURSDAY 3:45-4:45 or FRIDAY 5:15-6:15**

## BEGINNER II WESTERN (7-UP)

This is a class for students who have ridden at a trot and preferably cantered before but did not go in-depth into riding techniques. We will also be working on improving old skills and learning new ones.

**CLASS TIMES AND DAYS: TUESDAY 6:30-7:30 OR WEDNESDAY 4:00-5:00 OR THURSDAY 4:30-5:30**

## INTERMEDIATE (8-UP)

These lessons are for children who have participated in Beginner II previously. They should be able to perform on the horse: walk and trot transitions, reversing, and has cantered before. The lesson plans will be carried out with more emphasis on their riding technique, and will be moving towards more advanced horsemanship skills with an introduction to hunt seat and bareback riding.

**CLASS TIMES AND DAYS: MONDAY 6:30-7:30 OR TUESDAY 4:00-5:00 OR FRIDAY 6:30-7:30**

## ADVANCED (8-UP)

These lessons are for children who have had at least 4 semesters or more riding experience in riding lessons or approval from equestrian director. They should be able to perform on the horse; walk, trot, and canter transitions easily both English and Western. This class will focus on advanced western skills, equitation, trails, bareback riding, English, and introduction to jumping.

**CLASS TIMES AND DAYS: MONDAY 5:15-6:15 OR WEDNESDAY 5:15-6:15 OR FRIDAY 6:30-7:30**

## ADVANCED I. AND II./III. WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP AND HUNT SEAT

Students who are enrolling in this class must be able to perform walk, trot, and canter transitions easily both western and English.

Adv. I will be working on low jumping techniques.

Adv. II/III should be able to jump 2'3" fences and working on moving to higher fences and more advanced course work. Both classes will continue to work on improving the student's equitation in both western and English riding skills, jumping small courses, trail riding, and game events.

**CLASS TIMES AND DAYS: TUES. 5:15- 6:15 or FRIDAY 4:00-5:00(ADV I) , THURSDAY 6:00-7:00 (ADV. II/III) must have pre approval before registering for this class**
