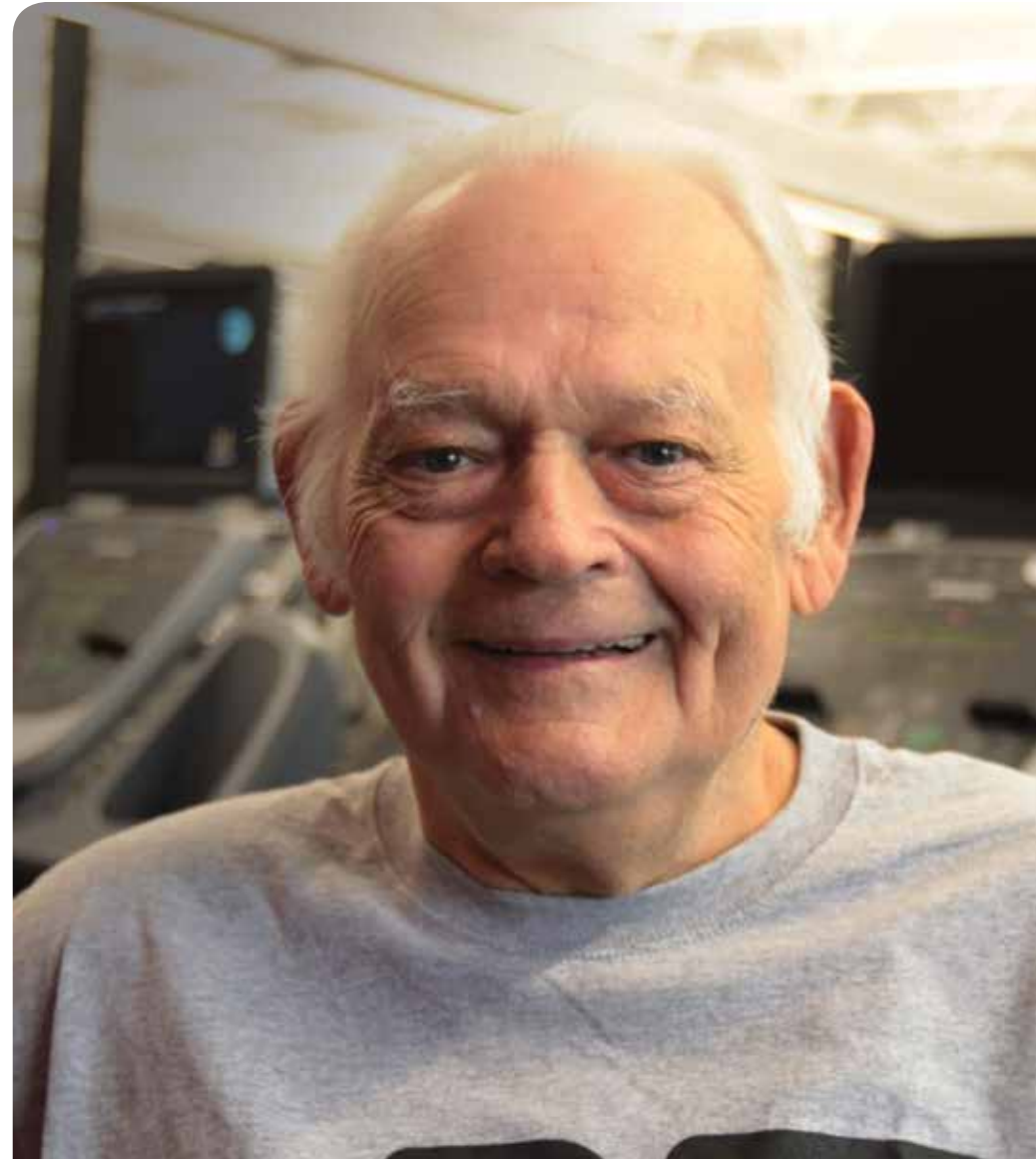
THEIR HEALTH

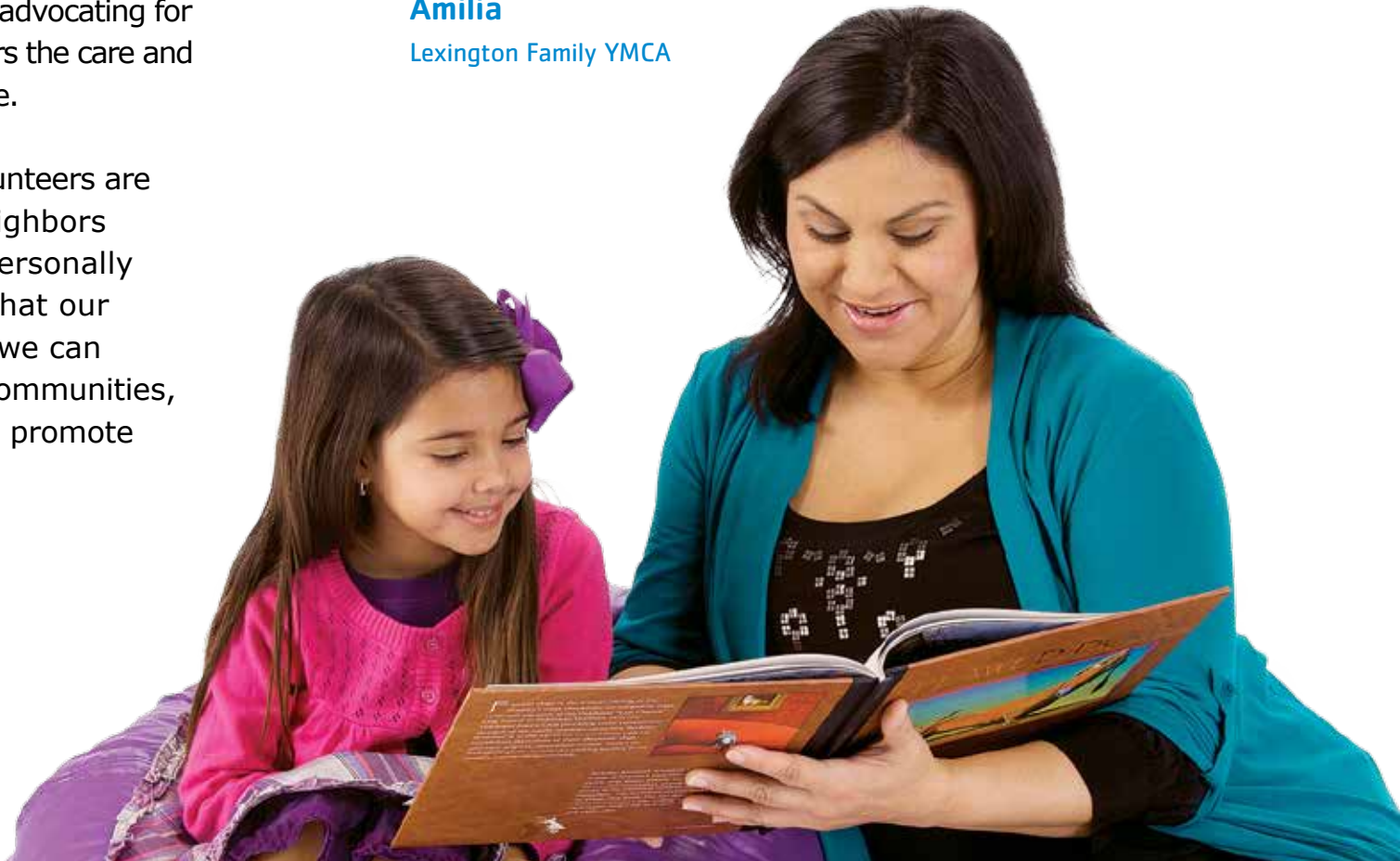
