The Counselor in Training (C.I.T.) program provides teens with training in how to use effective leadership skills throughout their lives and how to effectively lead children. CIT's are provided with training, leadership, and mentors as they assist in day camp programs and field trips.

CIT's must attend the training dates that will ensure they are comfortable and prepared to work with youth.

- Applicant must be able to attend the summer camp staff training prior to attending a Service Week.
- Applicant must have a strong desire to work with kids.
